

GCGS Main Match – Saturday, July 6, 2024

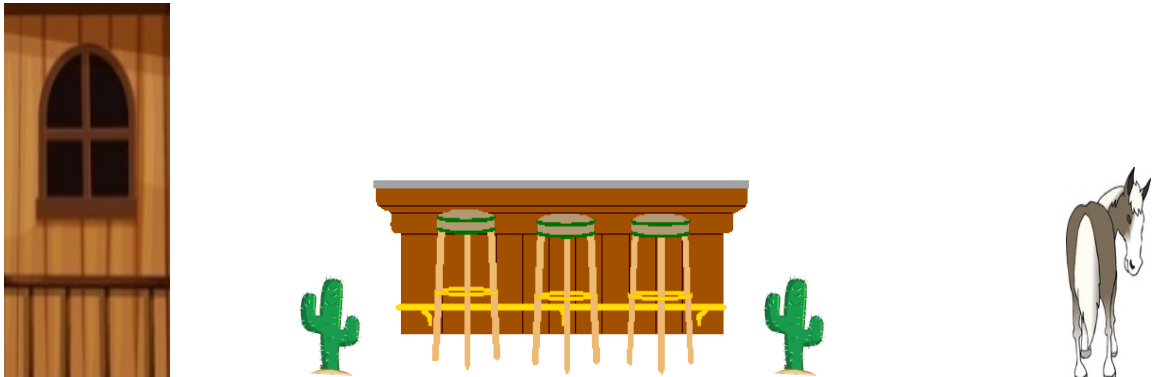
Stage 1

Patrick Henry – March 23, 1775

Pistols – 10 rds. holstered Rifle – 10 rds. on horse Shotgun – 4+ rds. on bar

Shooting order: shotgun, rifle, pistols

Shooter starts with back to the bar, with palms on bar. The line is, “Give me liberty or give me death!” ATB, turn to the bar and with shotgun, engage poppers. PMF. Restage shotgun on bar. Move to horse. With rifle, engage targets with a progressive sweep starting on either end and ending on the bottom circle. (1 on 1, 2 on 2, 3 on 3, 4 on 4) Restage rifle on horse. Move to window. With pistols, repeat rifle instructions. Holster.



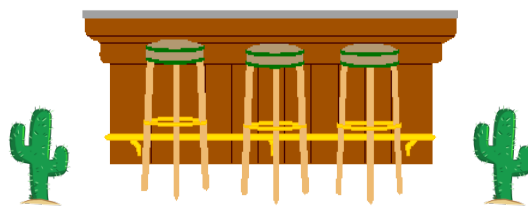
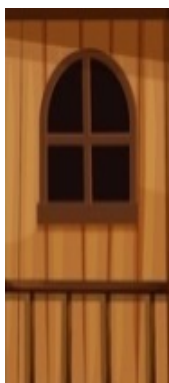
Stage 2

Colonel William Prescott – June 17, 1775

Pistols – 10 rds. holstered Rifle – 10 rds. on horse Shotgun – 4+ on bar

Shooting order: pistols, rifle, shotgun

Shooter starts at window, hands at Texas surrender. The line is, “**Don’t fire until you see the whites of their eyes.**” ATB, with pistols, double-tap each of the four targets in any order, then single-tap each of the outside targets. Holster. Move to horse and with rifle, repeat pistol instructions. Restage rifle safely on either the horse or the bar. Move to bar and with shotgun, knock down poppers. PMF.



Stage 3

Nathan Hale – September 22, 1776

Pistols – 10 rds. holstered Rifle – 10 rds. on rock table Shotgun – 6+ rds. on rock table

Shooting order: shotgun, rifle, pistols, shotgun OR shotgun, pistols, rifle, shotgun

Shooter starts in shooter's box, hands at sides. The line is, **"I only regret that I have but one life to lose for my country."** ATB, move to rock table. With shotgun, engage the two inner poppers. PMF. Restage. With rifle and pistols, engage targets with at least 6 rds each for 20 rds in any order. Holster pistols. Restage rifle. With shotgun, engage the remaining poppers. Knock 'em down.



Stage 4

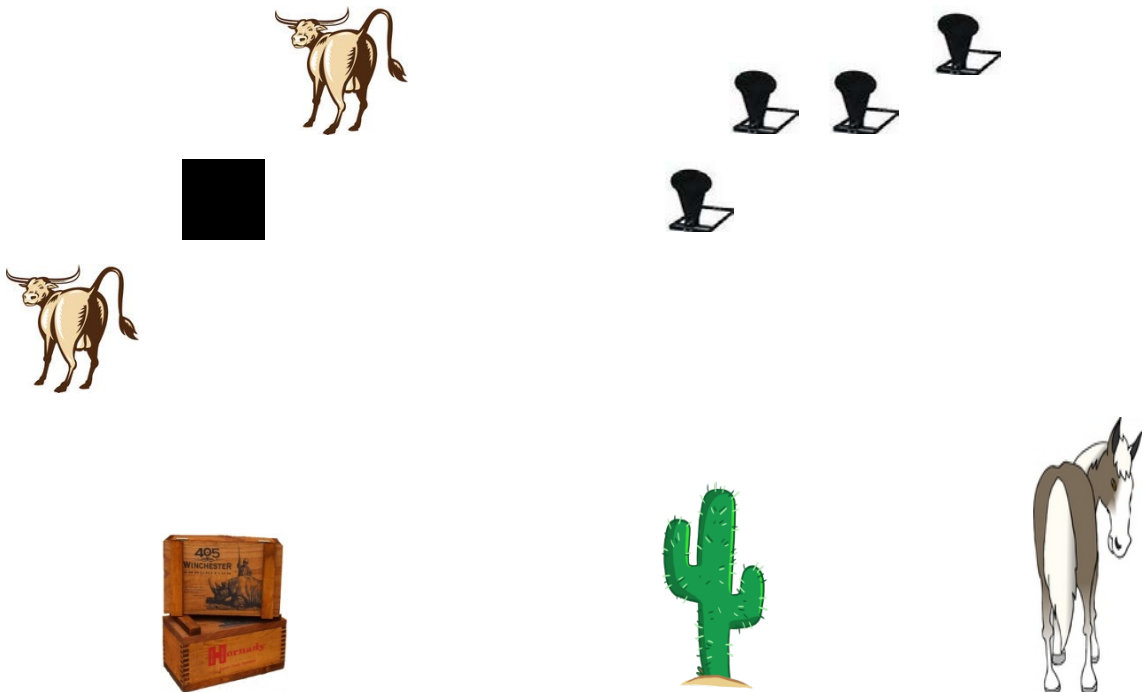
Confederate General Nathan Bedford – April 12, 1864

Pistols – 10 rds. holstered Rifle – 10 rds. on ammo boxes Shotgun – 4+ rds. on horse

Shooting order: pistols, rifle, shotgun OR rifle, pistols, shotgun

Shooter starts behind the ammo boxes, hands on hat. The line is, **“War is fighting, and fighting means killing.”** ATB:

Rifle and pistols – from behind ammo boxes, engage targets 2,4,6,8 starting with 2 rds. on the center target, 4 rds. on either end target, 6 rds. on the center target, then 8 rds. on the opposite end target. Holster pistols. Restage. Move to horse. With shotgun, knock 'em down. PMF



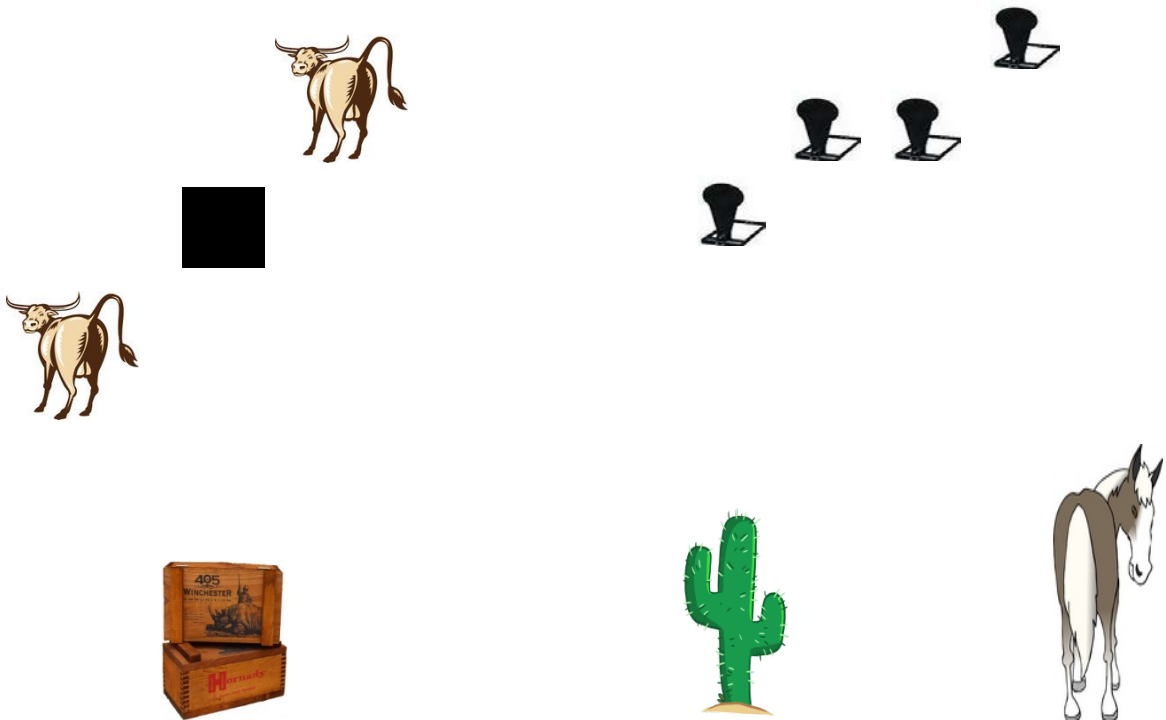
Stage 5

Brigadier General Anthony C. McAuliffe – December 22, 1944

Pistols – 10 rds. holstered Rifle – 10 rds. on ammo boxes Shotgun – 4+ rds. on horse

Shooting order: shotgun, rifle, pistols

Shooter starts beside horse, hands at sides. The line is, **“Give ‘em all nine yards.”** ATB, with shotgun knock ‘em down. PMF. Restage shotgun safely on horse or ammo box. Move to ammo boxes and with rifle from either end, sweep targets 3,1,1 twice, starting on the same target with each sweep. Then with pistols, repeat rifle instructions.



Stages 1 & 2

Steel – 6 blue uprights
2 short red uprights
3 large squares
5 large circles
4 poppers
10 bases

Props - 1 façade
1 bar
2 small cacti
1 horse

Stage 3

Steel – 3 white uprights
3 large circles
6 poppers
5 bases

Props - 1 rock table
2 small cacti
1 painted shooter box

Stage 4 & 5

Steel – 3 red uprights
2 bull's butts
1 large circle
4 poppers
3 bases

Props - 1 small ammo box
1 large ammo box
1 horse
1 large cactus
